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THE VOICE OF MANY WATERS

THE RIVER OF LIFE- *"And it shall come to pass in the last days, says God, that I will **pour out of my Spirit** on all flesh..." (Acts 2:17) This mighty outpouring of God's Spirit took place in Jerusalem, on the day of Pentecost, and Peter was addressing the many witnesses who had gathered there. He explained to them about Jesus who was raised from the dead, and *"Therefore being exalted to the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, He **poured out** this which you now see and hear."* (Acts 2:33) *"And those of the circumcision who believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because the gift of the Holy Spirit had been **poured out** on the Gentiles also."* (Acts 10:45)*

Note that the Holy Spirit was "poured out." He came down as fire, yet He is as a spring of living water springing up within. In our earthly vessel, He becomes a flow, a river of life. He is indeed, the river of life that flows in the midst of the city, the bride, the church, and washes over her soul, to cleanse her and make her holy. It is the flow of that river which gives life to all who yield themselves to the voice... *"...His voice as the sound of many waters."* (Rev.1:15) Yes, the voice of that river is the voice of the many-membered Christ who have stood in the truth revealed to them, and have left their footprints in the world. The voice of that river, cleanses our souls and quickens new life within. Out of that flow comes the pure Word of God, the truths that change our corrupt nature into Christ's beauty. His voice is heard in the streams of the apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors and teachers whom Jesus gave to His church. And His voice is that of the many pure waters who will soon be poured out to the world in the sons. *"And the Spirit and the bride say, "Come!" And let him who hears say, "Come!" And let him who thirsts come. Whoever desires, let him take the water of life freely."* (Rev.22:17)

In the life of that river, we find our union with God. *"And he showed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding from the throne of God and of the Lamb. In the middle of its street, and on either side of the river was the tree of life which bore twelve fruits, each tree yielding its fruit every month. The leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations."* (Rev.22:1-2) The source of the river is the throne of Father God, which is His power and authority, and the tree of life is Christ, the Word rooted in that life's source. A few rivers empty into lakes or dry basins, but most rivers, by the power of gravity, flow down to the seas and oceans. The seas or oceans symbolically represent humanity, and so the river of life also descends from the heights of the throne of God, to the lowly depth of the seas of humanity.

A SIGNIFICANT DREAM- During my youth, before my initial born-again experience with Jesus at the age of thirty, I had many dreams which came to pass in my personal life. I was not aware that these dreams were issuing from God's Spirit even though some were so vivid and impressive that I never forgot them; and many actually came to pass. It was after I began to know Jesus as my Savior, that my dreams became even clearer and more detailed; I knew they had important meanings, but I did not really understand them. At the time, my husband and I were content to be part of a non-denominational "Community Church." The pastor, a tall man, with a pleasant personality, expounded the Scriptures according to the Berean school of the Bible, which is strictly literal, but examines the words carefully; it was what we needed. We became acquainted with the scriptures, and grounded in the words of Jesus, it was perfect for us at the time. We had been attending for about two years, when I received this dream, *"I was with a few others, standing on the*

banks of a beautiful swift running river whose water was clear and abundant. There was a high, narrow bridge spanning the river. A couple was on the bridge; they were professional dancers, and they were dancing with much zeal and agility. Then at one point, the ring that was on the woman's finger slipped off and flew down into the river. They both looked from the bridge to see if they could see it, but they could not. The man then dove down and swam into the river looking for it but could never find it. Then, myself and the few who stood with me, retrieved a delicious freshly baked apple pie out of the river. I took the pie and held it up high offering it to the couple on the bridge, but at this point they became very irate and began to curse and carry on." I had no idea what the dream meant, but I knew I needed to find out; so my husband and I made an appointment to meet with our pastor. We sat crowded in his small office. He sat behind his large desk and we sat across from him. I related the dream to him. When I finished, his face was red with anger, and this man, who was always very calm and pleasant, stood up and in a very indignant manner asked for our letter of resignation; we quickly left the office. As I pondered this over the years, I believe that this man understood the meaning of this dream, but felt very threatened by it. We attended a couple more services, but each time he stared directly at us, warning the congregation of a strong deceiving enemy among them.

Shortly thereafter, the Lord led us to a group of saints who had also left their denominations. We stayed with them for about five years, and it was there that the Spirit taught me how to interpret dreams. Later, as we continued to grow in Christ, we were faced with similar circumstances as we had been with our pastor. Some were ministers who resisted God's truth, others were moving in some truths but were threatened by God's Word just the same. Thus this dream came to pass over and over again.

THE INTERPRETATION- The river in the dream, represents the *river of life* which is the stream of the Holy Spirit, the living Word of God that flows in our earth and speaks to our conscious minds through the voices of His called out people. The voices of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, the voices of Joseph, Isaiah and Jeremiah, the voice of Peter, John and Paul, and multitudes of voices of the past and present, are alive and speak from the river of life that flows in our midst. When John saw the vision of the resurrected Lord in His body of glory, he heard His voice and he saw Him too. *"His head and hair were white like wool, as white as snow, and His eyes a flame of fire. His feet were like fine brass, as if refined in a furnace, and **His voice as the sound of many waters.**"* (Rev.1:14-15) This was the vision of the complete, perfect Christ in His body of sons. The hair like wool speak of the mind of the Lamb who laid His life down, and those who follow Him wherever He goes. White as snow speaks of their righteous mind. Eyes a flame of fire, speaks of God's love as a consuming fire which destroys the lusts of the flesh, the sins of the world and the works of the devil. His love is the fire that consumed the sacrifice that Jesus laid on the cross, and His love is in Christ, reconciling the world unto Himself. *"Now all things are of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation...that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation."* (II Cor.5:18-19)

The high and narrow bridge with the professional dancers represents the superior position that some have assumed as teachers and leaders of God's sheep. Instead of being servants or ministers called of Christ, they are professionals demonstrating their talents, career oriented, looking for recognition, building profitable businesses, using worldly means to succeed. Many have attracted the people and have lured God's church, (the woman), to themselves with their charismatic and flamboyant personalities. They have taken the church on a whirly dance, and as a result, the union, (ring), has slipped off her finger, and these leader's efforts cannot retrieve it. When I offered that apple pie the man was furious. Apples represent the Word fitly spoken, *"A word fitly spoken is like apples of gold in pictures of silver."* (Prov.25:11) Also, the apples came prepared as a delicious pie, denoting that the Word is passed through the fire. It was presented by someone of no reputation, standing below their ranks, a woman without seminary degrees; it was humble pie. Eating

humble pie means to come with humbleness and admit that we were wrong. These ministers are called to humble themselves, turn from their errors, and partake of God's true words with humility. Instead their reaction is usually the same as that of my pastor long ago. During my many years on this walk, although I have never sought out any of these professionals, I have found myself face to face with many of them, and each time, the reaction of anger and indignation was the same.

As sons we draw the words of life from the Holy Spirit who dwells within, and from the many voices of the river of life that flows through brethren, through teachers and ministers of God's Word, through the many books of long ago and of today, through the stories of Abraham, Jacob, the prophets, the kings and all who speak to us by the way they lived. The words we hear are vibrant, clear and powerful. They come from the encouragement of those who took up their cross, and learned God's ways through suffering. Many are among the saints waiting under the altar for justice. *"When He, (the Lamb), opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of those who had been slain for the word of God and for the testimony which they held. And they cried with a loud voice saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, until You judge and avenge our blood on those who dwell on the earth? Then a white robe was given to each of them; and it was said to them that they should rest a little while longer, until both the number of their fellow servants and their brethren who would be killed as they were, was completed."* (Rev.6:9-11) Some had literally been killed, and many more had been rejected from the leaders and cast out as trash, because of their word.

"To him, (the true Shepherd), the door keeper opens, and the sheep hear his voice; and he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. And when he brings out his sheep, he goes before them, and the sheep follow him, for they know his voice. Yet they will by no means follow a stranger; but will flee from him, for they do not know the voice of strangers." (Jn.10:3-5) His sheep know and discern the voice; they ponder the truth in their hearts. They speak it to themselves and share it as He opens the way. His Word never returns to Him void; it is either received with joy, or it is rejected with disdain, but it does the work that it is sent to do. The prophet Isaiah compares God's word to the rain that waters the earth so that the seed might grow and produce the wheat for the bread that nourishes the people. *"So shall my word be that goes forth from my mouth; it shall not return to me void, but it shall accomplish what I please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it."* (Isa.55:11)

NOT BY MIGHT, NOT BY POWER, BUT BY MY SPIRIT SAITH THE LORD- The time has come for us to complete the journey that the saints began long ago. When God sent His Holy Spirit, He quickened the spirit of all who were gathered, waiting and expecting, with His mighty wind from on high, and filled their hearts with His love in the form of tongues of fire. Creation will soon be ready to receive the One who has promised deliverance from sin and corruption. Christ is that Deliverer, and much to their surprise, He is coming, not as one Man, but in the many sons that He has so faithfully raised into His likeness. It is time for the saints to stand, not looking to the right or to the left but straight ahead, following the narrow way. The word that the Spirit of God is consistently speaking to the saints today, is that now is the time to stand firmly, with resolute determination to move on to our goal in Christ.

The enemy of Christ is extremely cunning; he uses the most effective baits he has at his disposal to allure and captivate the saints, and distract them from their high calling in Christ. My heart is troubled when I see this happening to sons who know the truth, and have been pressing toward the mark of the high calling of God in Christ. Somehow, the small voice within them, has been overpowered by the loud voices of the herd, absorbed and even immersed into that which is happening in the world today. They are unaware that they are turning away from their calling in God, and taken captive by the powers of the arm of the flesh. Moses parted the Red sea by lifting his rod, and God drowned the entire army of Egypt. It is obvious that the peace and prosperity of the countries of this world must be guarded by military dominance to survive,

but God's ways in Christ are not by might nor power, but by God's Spirit. Sons of God are yearning for something much better. Paul exhorts us, ***"If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is sitting at the right hand of God. Set your mind on things above not on things on the earth."*** (Col.3:1-2)

TODAY, ALL WHO HAVE EARS TO HEAR AND HEARTS TO UNDERSTAND, are hearing the voice of the Archangel blowing the distinct, sharp and penetrating message of the last trumpet. This voice may come through dreams, revelations, by the witness of the Holy Spirit or all of the above, but it is clear and unmistakable. *"Be courageous and stand strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. Keep your soul, your emotions, your reactions, under the shadow of the Almighty, the quiet place within. Do not be disturbed or consumed by the turbulence of the world. Let my Spirit lead you above all the distractions that would carry you away from the final goal set before you. Know your calling and be resolute and stand fast in it, with determination. Keep your eyes on the vision that was given to you in the beginning. Follow Me only, so says the voice of the Archangel unto all of us."* Recently, I posted a dream, (jackiecap.site), sent to me by Tom, a brother from Canada. (See also page 5). His dream is a message from the Spirit, urging us to continue to the end of our journey in Christ, overcoming all the obstacles in the way, and to stand face to face and eye to eye with the will of God, not flinching but keeping our eyes steadily upon Him. This undeterred stand will open the way to the power of the right Hand of God, which in turn allows us to complete our journey and move into our calling of deliverers. Then the Christ man will arise, and open the door to that which could never be done by the power of the Adam man. To God be the glory forever.

OUR WONDROUS CALLING- Dream, *"My husband Michael and I were traveling with others. We were going to our final destination, each in our own car although we were traveling together. It was evening and we were checking out of our motel. We were packing our car and I told Michael to be sure to not forget my little red footstool to place under my feet in the car. Then standing by the car I see this tall nice-looking man. He looked very kind and extremely knowledgeable. I asked him if we could make it "home" in one trek. He said Yes, if you don't get too sleepy. We were traveling on a two-lane road, not on an expressway. There were 225 miles to go but because it was evening and we will be traveling by night, we will probably get sleepy. He said, "If you get too sleepy don't feel bad if you have to pull over, you must pull over." End of dream.* I had this dream several years ago, but today it has become more stirring and meaningful. Indeed, sons of God have been on a spiritual journey together, and yet each being dealt with very much alone; in our own car. The time of the last lap of the journey has been on-going. Two very significant things must be noted in the dream, one is "the little red footstool under my feet." Red is the color of blood which in this dream speaks of the life of the flesh. Paul writes that Christ is making the last enemy His footstool, and the last enemy that must be overcome is "death," the death of the flesh. This Word has been preached many times by brethren who went to their graves, yet overcame the life of the soul man within. The dream is showing us that we are now very close to the time when some will overcome death and the grave. This message sounds questionable and dubious, but it can no longer be buried. Those who preached it with conviction kept this truth alive, and now that they have passed through the veil, we are called to do the same, until all be fulfilled. They saw it and were convinced of it, and although we might be few, we who see and believe, must stand strong in our conviction. Like in the dream, some will still have to go to sleep along the way, there is no shame in that, but the day is at hand when the Spirit will cry aloud, *"O death where is thy sting, O grave where is thy victory!"* (I Cor.15:55) *"For He, (Christ), must reign until He has put all enemies under His feet. The last enemy that will be destroyed is death."* (I Cor.15:25-26) *"Sit at my right hand, till I make Your enemies your footstool."* (Heb.1:13) In the dream, the Spirit is saying, "Keep your feet on the little red footstool, until death is destroyed!"

The second thing to note in that dream is that we were 225 miles away from our destination. It took a while for the Spirit to get through to me that the last lap of our journey is written in the last chapter of the Bible. So I looked up Revelation 22 and I found the river of water of life, with the tree of life, and as I continued to read, I found that the end of this journey is a place, a condition, where there shall be no more curse, and where... *"They shall see His face, and His name shall be in their foreheads,* (they will have the nature and identity of Christ), *"...and verse 5, "There shall be no more night there. They need no lamp nor light of the sun, for the Lord gives them light. And they shall reign forever and ever."* We are now on the last lap of our journey toward this final goal where there is no more night, no more death, no more sorrow and *"Death is swallowed up in victory!"* (I Cor.15:54) The redemption of our body is the final and complete overcoming of death. We are at the dawn of that day, will this day be fully come in our own time? I believe it might.

TOM'S DREAM: *"Tom is walking in a parking lot; Yet a strange event has happened! Tom's car is completely surrounded by a multitude of people, standing shoulder to shoulder blocking off entrance to his car. What is interesting is no one else in the parking lot notices the multitude surrounding the car. They are oblivious to the situation. Without hesitation Tom moves closer to his car, then circles the car and stops at the driver's door, the man directly in front of the driver's door, stares intently at Tom... as in an intense staring match. No words are exchanged ... As in a silent battle of wills. After a length of time of silent battle of wills; within the fixation of such locked eyes...Without one word being spoken, Tom takes his right hand and gestures to the man in front of him to move... in that moment the man who locked eyes with Tom moved away as did all the group as in one movement. Still no words expressed! Tom enters the vehicle and drives away."*

INTERPRETATION- Although it seems it could be a threatening situation, there is no violence in the dream. It seems that Tom walked freely through this group of people who were surrounding his car, and he went straight to the man in front of the door, staring him in the eyes. There is determination and intensity, but no brutality. There is resistance with eye confrontation for a time, but no threat. Also this multitude of people, was not visible to the people going about their business in that parking lot, showing that these are spiritual symbols. These are important clues in the understanding of the dream. The people were blocking the way to the car but not with resistance; there were no weapons. They did not seem to be dangerous; but they had set themselves as obstacles, trying to intimidate Tom, and keep him from getting to his car.

Tom represents himself and all the sons of God also. The Spirit is saying that the next move is to go through all obstacles that are set in the way of our move on to the last leg of this overcoming journey in Christ. The multitude of people shoulder to shoulder represents the things that are set up to block the way, such as the many thoughts of defeat or unbelief in our calling as sons of God, the discouraging words of those who cannot understand us, the traditions that are hard to break, the attachments to things and people that tempt us to turn from the straight and narrow road and so on... Tom walked through all that with no fear and no hesitation, showing the maturity that has come to God's firstfruit sons. However, there is one more test to go through before Tom could get into his car and move on. The Spirit is showing that the last test at this time is to fix our vision upon Christ, and be steadfast in eye to eye agreement with God's plan and God's will. In the dream, it took a period of time of holding on to this eye to eye contact. Tom had to stare with determination, and not lower his vision. It is when we see eye to eye with the Spirit that we are then given the power of the right hand of God, and are able to waive the last obstacle out of the way and open the door to move on to complete our journey in Christ
