

URIM AND THUMMIM

Urim and Thummim— essential elements for a servant/son of God (on the inside).

“And you shall put in (inside) the breastplate of judgment, the Urim and the Thummim, and they shall be over Aaron’s heart when he goes in before the Lord...” Exodus 28: 30

The one wearing the “breastplate of judgement” will then have righteous judgment. There is understanding when you see them as symbolism; when you know that Urim means lights and Thummim means perfections (translated from Hebrew). The priest must have these in his heart to enter the Holy of Holies or the presence of God.

This was thousands of years before Jesus came to restore the light and the perfection of the spirit of God to the world. “I AM the light of the world. Whoever follows Me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.” “... and in Him you have been made complete (perfect), and He is the head over all rule and authority.” “... the perfecting of the saints, for the work of service, for the edifying of the body of Christ; til we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ.”
