

New

There are around 6 words translated “new” in the New Testament.

Four of them are listed once or twice.

The 5th one is 3501 - *neos neoterus* - listed 24 times and it is used with respect to age; as in *new* wine (in opposition to old or more aged wine).

In other places the word is translated *young- er; man, women, etc.*

The 6th word is 2537 – *kainos* – which means “new” with respect to *freshness*.

This word is listed 44 times in the NT.

It gives us a “fresh” understanding of the things our Savior did for us and of the things to come:

New bottles :

Mat 9:17 Neither do men put new wine into old bottles: else the bottles break, and the wine runneth out, and the bottles perish: but they put new wine into **new** bottles, and both are preserved.

Ministry equipped with new treasures:

Mat 13:52 Then said he unto them, **Therefore every scribe which is instructed unto the kingdom of heaven is like unto a man that is an householder, which bringeth forth out of his treasure things new and old.**

New (& better) testament/covenant:

Mat 26:28 For this is my blood of the **new** testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.

Heb 8:8 For finding fault with them, he saith, Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, when I will make a **new** covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah:

Heb 8:13 In that he saith, A **new** covenant, he hath made the first old. Now that which decayeth and waxeth old is ready to vanish away.

New tongues:

Mar 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with **new** tongues;

New commandment (new because.....):

Joh 13:34 A **new** commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another.

1Jn 2:7 Brethren, I write no **new** commandment unto you, but an old commandment which ye had from the beginning. The old commandment is the word which ye have heard from the beginning.

1Jn 2:8 Again, a **new** commandment I write unto you, which thing is true in him and in you: because the darkness is past, and the true light now shineth.

New creatures with all things new:

2Co 5:17 Therefore if any man *be* in Christ, *he is* a **new** creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become **new**.

New man:

Eph 2:15 Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, *even* the law of commandments *contained* in ordinances; for to make in himself of twain one **new** man, *so* making peace;

Eph 4:24 And that ye put on the **new** man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.

A white stone with a new name:

Rev 2:17 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a **new** name written, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth *it*.

A new City with His new name:

Rev 3:12 Him that overcometh will I make a pillar in the temple of my God, and he shall go no more out: and I will write upon him the name of my God, and the name of the city of my God, *which is* **new** Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from my God: and *I will write upon him my new name*.

Rev 21:2 And I John saw the holy city, **new** Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

A new song:

Rev 5:9 And they sung a **new** song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation;

Rev 14:3 And they sung as it were a **new** song before the throne, and before the four beasts, and the elders: and no man could learn that song but the hundred *and* forty *and* four thousand, which were redeemed from the earth.

New heaven(s) & new earth :

2Pe 3:13 Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for **new** heavens and a **new** earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness.

Rev 21:1 And I saw a **new** heaven and a **new** earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea.

This is the last time new-2537 is used in The Bible and appropriately so:

Rev 21:5 And he that sat upon the throne said,

Behold, I make ALL things new.

Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus!
