WITNESS IN EARTH AS IN HEAVEN

The Law of God teaches that at the mouth of two or three witnesses, every word is established. A man could not be condemned to death without the witness of two or three persons. Jesus affirmed, “*..in the mouth of two or three witnesses every word may be established.*” (Matt. 18: 16b)

“*Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God.*” (Matt.16: 16) This was a seemingly very simple answer from Peter, but what Peter did not realize was that when he identified the Son, his own mouth was witnessing the Father's heavenly Word in the earth. The Father had given him the answer from the Spirit and he spoke it in the earth. His witness established the truth that Jesus was indeed the Christ, the Son of the living God. Jesus confirmed this, “*..flesh and blood hath not revealed it unto thee, but my Father which is in heaven.*” (Vs.17)

And so it is for us today, flesh and blood has not revealed the truths that we hold onto; they were revealed to us by the Spirit of the living God. We share each other's revelations and we read many great teachings, but it is only when the Spirit within us witnesses to these, that we are quickened to new life.

Through the Holy Spirit, we are the witnesses of Jesus Christ. His Word is established in the earth by our witness. “*But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: AND YE SHALL BE WITNESSES UNTO ME... unto the uttermost part of the earth.*”(Acts 1:8)

The Law of the Old Covenant and the Word of the prophets are two witnesses that establish God's Word in the earth. The Spirit speaks the Word to us

from heaven (Spirit) and it is established in earth by our speaking it. Heaven and earth are the witnesses of His Word today. The Spirit is the inner voice that utters the Word to our hearing ear, and the Word that we speak out of our mouths is the witness in the earth that establishes that Word.

When the Lord speaks to us through a dream and we understand its meaning and witness to it, we have established that Word in the earth.

What comes from heaven in us, (Holy Spirit) is then established at the MOUTH of two or three witnesses. Jesus told Peter, “*And I will give you the keys to the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven; and whatsoever thou shalt lose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.*” (Matt.16: 19)

Jesus said this to one who could hear from the Father. And so it is for us who are His church today; we are led by the Holy Spirit, and we are called to verbally bind or loose whatsoever stands in the way of what we hear by the Spirit. We have been given the keys of the kingdom and we are storming the gates of hell; they shall not prevail against us.

We are all in school, learning to hear from the Father as Peter did on that day. We may not all be at the same grade level, but we all have the same Teacher. The Word for the day in this school of life, is the same at all levels, only the Teacher gives to each the proper understanding and training.

This is a very unique school in that each Word taught is then applied in daily lives. It is passed through the fire. As the song we have sung so

many times declares, “ *God leads His dear children along. Some through the waters and some through the flood, some through the fire but all through the blood. Some through great sorrow, but God gives a song, in the night season and all the day long.*”

When Simon Barjona answered Jesus' question, he had no idea that the Father had spoken to him. Simon was still very young in the Lord. He was a believer, but he was not yet endowed with the Holy Spirit; nevertheless he heard from the Father.

Our Father has poured out His Holy Spirit to reveal His many mysteries to us. We are students in this school of life until we know Christ, the Son of the living God, and we are as He really is in creation.

IT'S OMEGA TIME!

Several years ago, the Lord gave me this dream, “*I was walking on a path through the woods when I came to a clearing. There on the side of the path was a large smooth rock. On top of the rock was a watch. I picked it up and saw that it was a gold Omega wristwatch. I put it on for the rest of my journey.*”

My own brother actually had a gold Omega watch; I still have it. However, the dream was not about that tangible watch, it was about God's hour in which we now live. This dream came several years ago, and the Lord was saying at that time, that His church (of which we are a part) had already begun the last leg of her journey. The Omega hour is now being fulfilled.

The journey of the Christ Seed began long, long ago, the Alpha hour has now met up with the Omega hour which is well on its way. We know that Alpha is the first letter of the Greek alphabet and Omega is the last letter. These two letters have been adopted by the church as a symbol of Christianity. They point to the beginning and the end of the creation of God.

It is with the voice of a great trumpet that the Lord Jesus, the resurrected Son of God declares, “*I am the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the*

ending, saith the Lord, which is and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty.” (Rev.1: 8) “*I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last...*” (Rev.1: 11a) He also introduces Himself as, “*The Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation of God.*” (Rev.3: 14)

When here on earth, our Lord Jesus was the faithful and true witness of the Father. Now by His Spirit within us, He has made us that same witness. “*...when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak, and he will shew you things to come.*” (Jn.16: 13) The Holy Spirit is the witness of the Word and He speaks that Word to us who are His witnesses in the earth.

John the Revelator wrote of the witnesses who have been laying dead in the streets of the city...the church. But now the Spirit of holiness has raised up these witnesses as His firstfruits. They are joining the trumpet sound which is already shaking the earth, until ONLY those things which cannot be shaken remain. (see Heb.12: 27)

The One who identifies Himself as the Alpha and Omega is also telling us that He is the Beginning of the creation. God the Father took the Son (Word) out of Himself and by Him began an ongoing creation of earthly beings, among whom He has reproduced His own image.

These earthly beings are not meant to be annihilated. It is their carnal earthly natures that are being broken with a rod of iron (Word of God), and dashed in pieces like a potter's vessel until it is ready to be joined in marriage to the heavenly Seed and become a brand new creation of God. The earthly man is the clay in the potter's hands. It is worked and broken and worked, and finally put through the fire to become fit for the Potter's use.

First that which is natural, then that which is spiritual, then the two giving birth to a brand new creation. It is for that purpose that the Son of God was sent into earth. Surely this is the profound mystery that Paul had begun to unfurl for us as he said,

“And when ALL THINGS (created things and people), shall be subdued unto him (the Son) then shall the Son also himself be subject unto him that put all things under him, that God may be all in all.” (I Cor.15: 28)

In other words, when the Son of the living God has brought all creatures and things unto the obedience of Christ, the Father will then rule a new creation...not a temporal creation but an eternal creation of God in Christ. We are living in the Omega time, when the appearing of the Christ creation is about to take place in the world.

A CLOSER LOOK AT CREATION

Archaeologists tell us that creation began millions of years ago. Substantial evidence proves that to be true. This means that long before the Adam man came on the scene, God created the heavens and the earth, and all that accompanies them. The first chapter of Genesis explains all of that.

The creation of man is complex. Paul states that there are mysteries that can only be revealed by the Spirit of God. When Jesus spoke of the Holy Spirit, He called Him the “Spirit of truth” who will lead you into all truth. He said, *“I have yet many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now. Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth...” (Jn.16: 12-13a)*

It was not because these disciples had little faith and would not believe that Jesus could not tell them what was on His heart at the time; it was because they were not spiritually mature and just could not understand.

However, since then, the Church that Jesus has been building has passed through many floods and fires and has come to a measure of maturity. The words that Jesus spoke to His bewildered disciples, and much more, have now been made flesh in a body of people. Our eyes have been opened, our ears have been tuned to hear, and our hearts have been softened to understand the deep things of God.

And so the Christ, Son of the living God is reveal-

ing Himself, and the great mysteries that have been hid in Him from the foundation of the world are coming to light.

THE ELOHYIM

To understand how the Son of God became the beginning and the end of the creation of God, we need to first understand the difference that the Scriptures present, between the Father and the Son. Jesus said, *“I can of mine own self do nothing...I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me.” (Jn.5: 30a,c)*

The Father and the Son are one, yet for the purpose of creation they are separated. The word “God” that appears in Genesis one, is the Hebrew word Elohyim which means “Supreme God.” Elohyim is the Creator, the Owner of the Universe. The “Word” was in God and with God for the Word is also God. *“In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.” (Jn.1: 1)*

The Elohyim creation unfolds in details, in the first chapter of Genesis. The supreme God finished His creation in six days, or six ages. Then He rested from all His work which He had made. Long before God spoke the creation into being, He had drawn definite complex blueprints of His complete plan. When He rested, after six days, His creation was far from complete.

I remember in a dream, *“I was running through an airport to catch a jet flight. I had a large roll of blueprints under my arms and I was eager to look at them. However, I knew that they could not be unfolded until I was on the jet and had reached maximum altitude.”* Indeed, the blueprints have been drawn and they are hid in Christ. However, it is only when we have reached a maximum place in the Spirit that we are able to unfold the plans.

As part of the six-day creation, Elohyim created a most important man...the Man in His own image! For this, Elohyim reached within Himself and brought forth the One called “the Word,” the Son of God who had been in God. It was with the Son in Him that the Father had created all things. It is the only Son that the Father begot from His own loins,

who is in God's image. And it is with a special purpose that the Father separates the Son from within Himself, and sends Him in the earth. *"..gave his only begotten Son.."* His Son is the One who is appointed to bring forth an earthly creation in His own image. What a gift this is, what a superb achievement!

No wonder when the time came, Jesus was ready and prayed, *"Father, the hour is come; glorify thy Son, that thy Son also may glorify thee...And now O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was."* (Jn.17:1b, 5) The Son was ready to return and be One with the Father as He had been before the separation.

And in time, the entire creation, the Son Himself will turn the creation over to the Father that God may be all in all.

**JEHOVAH-ELOHYIM
THE SELF-EXISTENT ONE
THE BEGINNING OF THE CREATION
OF GOD**

"So God created a man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them." (Gen.1:27) *"And again when he bringeth in the first begotten into the world, he saith, and let all the angels of God worship him."* (Vs.6)

This is speaking of the Son that Elohyim brought out of Himself and sent into His earthly creation. The Father gave this man and woman (for he was male and female), dominion over every creature that He had created in the earth. He also blessed them and commissioned them to *"Be fruitful and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it."* (Vs.28a) And God saw that everything He had made was VERY GOOD. (Vs.31)

We know that God is Spirit, He lives in eternity and has no beginning nor end. it is important to note that starting at Genesis chapter two and verse seven, God is no longer addressed as just GOD; He is now addressed as THE LORD GOD.

This is very significant because now we know that God the Elohyim had delegated the creation of man to His Son, Jehovah-Elohyim. The Word had now come to dwell with earthly man. The Alpha or the Beginning, has now come on the scene to begin the work of the seventh day; the work that the Father assigned to Him. He is the Author and the Finisher. He begins as the Alpha and finishes as the Omega.

It was a new day in creation when the Son of God, JEHOVAH-ELOHYIM or THE LORD GOD took over the work that the Father had given Him to do. Throughout the Scriptures, the Son of God is called "the Lord God." He is the "Self-Existent" One. He is God in the creation. He is able to communicate and fellowship with man.

In fact, the Son of God, can appear in whatever form He needs to be to reveal Himself; He has life within Himself, *"For as the Father hath life in himself; so hath he given to the Son to have life in himself."* (Jn.5: 26) The Son does not depend on anything or anyone to sustain His life. He can even live with or without air or water or food as He will.

The Son of God can transform Himself into whatever form He chooses. He was the Rock that followed them in the wilderness, and He is the Seed in Abraham. He is the Christ in the earth. He is the Word that was with God and that is God.

He is the Lord Jehovah-Jireh the Provider and Jehovah Nissi, Jehovah my banner, the One who leads unto victory in battle. The Lord God is Jehovah in all of His dealings with men.

When God handed the creation over to the Son, there was a lot of work to be done. There were creatures in the earth. We know this because archaeologists have found and analyzed remains of some of these prehistoric creatures. Their bones or fossils were found buried in the earth. They were then reconstructed to reveal what kind of human beings they once were.

Archeologists tell us that perhaps ten thousands years or so ago, such as cave men and denisovans dwelt in the earth. Bones and fossils have been

found in Africa and Asia that lead them to believe that multiple groups of humans have existed over the eons of time. The bones of the Neanderthals were found in caves in Europe. There are ongoing studies of these, and now with the help of DNA, scientists are able to get clearer insight on the subject, although there are still many unanswered questions that only the Spirit of God can reveal.

However it is very possible that God created multiple species of humans in the earth long before Adam came to be. The Bible and researchers both agree that none of these knew how to till the ground and cultivate the soil in order to grow the many seeds that were available. They must have survived by being hunters and gatherers; none were farmers.

It is also believed that these humans did not have “language” as we do to communicate. The “Word” was not among them. They mainly understood each other by signs, gestures and such. By the Spirit, we can safely state that none of these creations had the essential characteristics to learn or develop into beings who could ever become sons of God. A new creation man was needed in the earth.

And so, the man that Elohyim created in His own image was sent to the earth with the solemn mission of multiplying His own image in man, and to bring God's earthly creation into an eternal kingdom for the Father to abide.

The first order of things was to form a man who could cultivate the earth. God had created the earth and all manners of seeds, but there was not a man that could plant, fertilize and grow crops to harvest. Everything that has life in the earth begins with a seed. The earth is the ground where seeds are planted. “*..and there was not a man to till the ground.*” (Gen.2: 5b)

A NEW HUMAN IS HERE

*“The Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man **became a living soul.**”* (Gen.2: 7)

The Lord God (Jehovah-Elohyim) wasted no time.

He proceeded to form man out of the dust of the ground; a man who could live in the earth and till the ground. Archaeologists may call this man, “homo-sepien” or “wise man, but the Bible calls him “*Adam, “which was of God, or the son of God.*” (Lk.3: 38b)

Archaeologists may have made great advances in finding how some of the prehistoric men lived, but none can truly and unequivocally answer the question of how they first came into being. And where did the homosepiens (us), who replaced the Neanderthals really come from. They know that the species could intermarry and have children, but that few did that.

These findings may or may not be an answer to the question, “Who lived in the land of Nod when Cain was banished from the garden and went to begin a family there.?” (see Gen.4: 16-17) It may also answer the mystery of “Who were the daughters of men with whom the sons of God procreated giants in the land?” (see Gen.6: 1-2)

Scientists have discovered that there is a minuscule trace of Neanderthal DNA mixed in our homosepien humanity today. They now propose that man did not evolve from one species to another; each is separate from the other. Recent studies have concluded that the Neanderthals were not a sub species from modern man; they were simply a species that lived in the earth prior to our own.

So it is that the Lord God took of the dust of the earth and formed a brand new man. According to modern science, we are homosepiens which means “wise men.” From his beginning, this man was endowed in a special way, for the Lord God who was a “life-giving Spirit” had breathed the breath of life into his nostrils. When the breath of life entered into the vessel of clay, something different and very special happened, man became a LIVING SOUL!

This man was not just a created mammal in the earth; this man had something of God within his very being. The Word had been breathed into him and he could communicate as no other man had ever done before. The soul is comprised of the intel-

lect, the affections and the identity. This man's intellect was superior to any of the previous creations, this is why scientists called him "wise man" or homo-sepien. This man could not only speak and understand words and hold a conversation, he could also learn. He had a mind (soul) that could develop and invent useful things and solve complex problems.

In time he would make many intricate and significant discoveries in the world of science, medicine, technology and in all things pertaining to his world. He would travel and explore every corner of his planet and even find ways to go to the moon and more as we know. There are seemingly no limits to what this "soulish" homo-sepien man can accomplish in this universe, for he lives by the breath of God.

THE GARDEN AND THE SEED

When the Son of God formed the man of dust, He gave him his own unique domain. *"And the Lord God planted a garden eastward in Eden; and there he put the man whom he had formed."* (Gen.2: 8) There were all kinds of wonderful things in Eden. There were rivers of flowing water, there were precious stones and there were many trees. We know about the two famous trees of Eden.

This garden may well have existed somewhere in the Middle East, but above all, this garden speaks to us of that special inner place called the "soul and the mind". It is there that the seeds of thoughts and ideas are planted and cultivated. It is there that we find a tree with a talking serpent and a forbidden fruit. It is also the place wherein is the Tree of Life and rivers of living waters. And it is the place given to the man and his wife to keep and to carefully tend.

In the parables, Jesus explains that the world is the field in which the Sower plants the seeds. The field that Jesus is speaking of is the mind and soul of the Adam man. When Jehovah-Elohyim created the man of dust and breathed in him the breath of life, His plan was NOT to only bring forth a creation of the earth; His goal was to take that man

from the earthly to the heavenly. God promised Abraham that his seed would not only be as the dust of the earth, but also as the stars of heaven. This speak of an earthly and a heavenly creation.

Because man's understanding has been limited by his immaturity, man has imagined a heaven in space where, with good behavior, man's soul could spend a blissful eternity, while his body went to the grave. This is kindergarten doctrine.

The Lord God needed a specific man, made of earth, in whom He could plant the seed of Himself, and bring that seed to fruition or maturity. The Seed that the Lord God planted in the field or in man's soul, is most precious and rare. When it appears in its full glory, it will be the perfect image of the Son of God. The Lord Jesus Christ is the pattern of the Seed made flesh. He is the Firstborn among many brethren.

The fruit of that Seed had never been harvested in creation before Jesus came in the earth. That Seed is the hidden Christ, even the *"..mystery that has been hid among the Gentiles, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory."* (Col.1: 27b) This surely is a mystery for who would believe such a thing?

Concerning the Christ that shall grow in the earth, the prophet of old cried out, *"Who hath believed our report? And to whom is the arm of the Lord revealed? For he shall grow up before him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: he hath no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see him, there is no beauty that we should desire him."* (Isa.53: 1-2)

This powerful prophecy applies first to the Christ who was formed in the womb of His mother Mary. But without a doubt, this is also the prophecy of the forming and birthing of the Body of Christ in a people who has been made virgin by the Holy Spirit.

Jesus taught, *"Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit."* (Jn.12: 24) Christ is *".. the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world."* (Rev.13:8b) Christ is

the corn of wheat that was planted in the field and died from the foundation of the world. The soul is the field where the Seed is planted. Jesus taught about the struggle of the Seed by way of parables. As we have grown to spiritual maturity, we have personally experienced the Christ struggling to take dominion over the “strong man of our house”, our own carnal nature. The harvest of the Firstfruits is the first harvest of that Seed in vessels of clay. Now is the Omega hour and the complete victory of the Seed over the man of flesh is at hand. My study No.222- “The Journey of the Seed”, recounts times in the Old Testament, when carnal men tried to destroy the Seed that God had given to the women who were called to give birth to the next child in the lineage of Jesus Christ. The genealogy records of Matthew show Jesus Christ, being the forty-first generation of the Seed and the Body of Christ being the forty-second generation.

“So all the generations from Abraham to David are fourteen generations; and from David until the carrying away into Babylon are fourteen generations; and from the carrying away into Babylon unto Christ are fourteen generations.” (Matt.1:17). When we count the generations until Jesus Christ there are only thirteen generations. So it is evident that the Christ generations recorded in Matthew is the Body of Christ which counts for the forty-second generation. This has been the subject of several studies from various anointed ministries.

Jesus taught that the Seed has been planted in the man of earth and that an enemy has been busy planting tares as well. The enemy is the carnal mind in us and in those who teach and influence us. Each tare has to be pulled up by the root and destroyed by fire. This is all part of the forming of this new man within us and it is all part of our learning experience and training for the ages to come.

AGES TO COME

Very long time periods or eons are also referred to as “ages.” There were the stone age, the iron age, the bronze age according to the development of technology. There are also ages in the Bible which refer to specific but indeterminate time periods in

which God deals with creation. We know by the Spirit, that creation is always progressing toward the completion of God's plan.

Ages are in “time zone” within eternity. There have been many ages before the one we now live in, and the Bible teaches that there are more ages to come. *“That **in the ages to come** he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace in his kindness toward us through Christ Jesus.”* (Eph.2: 7)

We know that it is in this age that Jesus, the Son of God has been building His Church or Bride company that has received His Seed (Word) and has given birth to the Firstfruits of a new creation of God in the earth. The Son of God has been given the mission of subduing all things unto Himself and so the Son who is the King, has been gathering all things into His kingdom. When the work is completed, He will turn the kingdom over to the Father.

“Then cometh the end, when he (the Son) shall have delivered up the kingdom to God, even the Father; when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and power. For he must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet. The last enemy that shall be destroyed is death. ...And when all things shall be subdued unto him, then shall the Son also himself be subject unto him that put all things under him, that God may be all in all.” (I Cor.15: 24-26,28)

The Lord God is King of His vast domain, in heaven and in earth! He is the One who is anointed to deliver us from the powers of darkness and translate us from earthly to heavenly, into the dear Son's Kingdom. The Lord God is the only One who can take us from death unto life. He is the One who rules and reigns in the hearts of those who have put away the “old man”. He is the First and the Last of the Adam creation. We are His inheritance and He is ours. The Father gave Him all authority and power over the heavens and the earth for the purpose of beginning and finishing this mighty work.

And now the Son is bringing all governments under the authority of God's government. *“And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in*

heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord and of his Christ; and he shall reign forever and ever.” (Rev.11: 15)

Before leaving the earth realm, Jesus explained that He was going to the Father! He was returning to the place (dimension of life) He once had with the Father. His work here on earth was now finished. The rest being accomplished by the people of His Body (His true Church).

A PLACE IN FATHER'S HOUSE

“In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there you may be also.” (Jn.14: 2-3)

When Jesus said He was going to prepare a place for us, that where He is, there we may be also, He was not speaking of a geographic location, or a heaven somewhere in space; He was speaking of a dimension of life; the same life that He has with the Father. He was speaking about the Father.

The fourteenth chapter of the Gospel of John is not speaking of Jesus going to prepare a place in a “heaven” somewhere in space, as many teach. The word “heaven” does not appear at all in that chapter but the word “Father” appears twenty-two times!

In recent dreams, the Lord showed me that He is leading us to Father's house. This is not a place we go after we die; it is a level of life. Jesus prepared this place for us when He went to the cross, died, and was raised from the dead. He sent that same Spirit who raised Him from the dead to dwell within us, to walk us through the baptism of fire, to quicken our mortal bodies and take us where He is.

Jesus told the disciples, *“And whither I go ye know, and the way ye know.” (Vs.4)* But they were baffled and Thomas quickly spoke up, *“Lord, we know not whither thou goest; and how can we know the way?”* Jesus was quick to respond, *“I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh to the Father, but by me.” (Jn.14: 6)* We do not know the

way to Father's house, but Jesus, by His Holy Spirit is leading us there.

Paul knew that He had been called to a much higher level of life than just simply being saved from death. Paul prayed, *“Not as though I had already attained, either were already perfect: but I follow after, if that I may apprehend that which also I am **apprehended** for.” (Ph.3: 12)*

This word “apprehended” is a powerful word. Webster's dictionary defines it as: to arrest, to take into custody by legal authority, to seize, to grab, to capture. This is what happened to Saul as he was thrown from his horse by the resurrected Lord Jesus Christ. Paul was not among those with a “whosoever will” calling. He was among those who were predestinated in Christ from the foundation of the world. He was apprehended. From that time forward, Paul was not just looking for life beyond this death, Paul was pressing for a greater level of life. He was **apprehending** or seizing the high calling of God in Christ Jesus.

Salvation through the blood of Jesus totally covers the world. But it takes a walk with the Spirit to attain to perfection in Christ. This happens as we walk circumspectly with Him through the fires of our every day lives, to the purifying of our souls and the transformation of our carnal minds unto the mind of Christ.

It is as the Christ man within takes dominion over our entire being (spirit, soul and body), that we are transformed into His image. This has been the work of the Spirit of God in His Church throughout this age. Now the Church is ready and waiting on both sides of the veil, to enter into the age to come!

May Father, Son and Holy Spirit bless us all and complete their work in us as we continue this marvelous, fabulous journey together!
